WHEREAS, trees can reduce the erosion of our precious topsoil by wind, and water, lower our heating and cooling costs, moderate the temperature, clean the air, produce oxygen, and provide habitat for wildlife; and

WHEREAS, trees are a renewable resource giving us paper, wood for our homes, fuel for our fires and countless other wood products; and

WHEREAS, trees in our town increase property values, enhance the economic vitality of our business areas, and beautify our community; and

WHEREAS, trees, wherever they are planted, are a source of joy and spiritual renewal; and

WHEREAS, The Town of Warwick has been recognized as a Tree City 10 years in a row.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Jesse Dwyer, Supervisor of the Town of Warwick do hereby proclaim April 24, 2026 as Arbor Day in the Town of Warwick, New York and I urge all citizens to celebrate Arbor Day and to support efforts to protect our trees and woodlands; and

FURTHER, I urge all citizens to plant trees to gladden the heart and promote the well-being of this and future generations.
