COUNCILMAN DE ANGELO REPORT

1. The Post Report for July 2021 is as follows: Greenwood Lake had 139 calls, the Town outside the Village had 521 calls, Pine Island had 237 calls, the Village of Warwick had 490 calls and the Greenwood Lake Volunteer Ambulance District had 75 calls for a total of 1,462 for the month of July.
2. The Warwick Valley Humane Society has expanded their Senior Program to help or

local senior citizens provide proper care for their pets. They are now offering services to make grooming and veterinary appointments, provide transportation and food as needed and be listed as your pet's emergency contact. If you have no family to keep in touch with you, lets set up a check in schedule. All you have to do is contact the Humane Society at 845-986-2473 and let them help.

3. Our Seniors for Seniors year-round Adoption Program was initiated in an effort to place our older animals with people 60 years and older as a better match for both. We waive the adoption fee except for the \$10.00 dog license fee. This pairing offers companionship, mutual affection and a purpose to get up in the morning. Senior pets need less activity not no activity, are already house and leash trained, are a shorter commitment and are so grateful to once again have a home in their golden years. They currently have several senior dogs for adoption. All are available to be seen on their website at wvhumane.org.

4. Jordan Way Fundraiser was held last Saturday night and it was a huge success, adding over \$8,000.00 to the Capital Campaign fund for the new facility.

5. Warwick Humane is participating in the Clear the Shelters event to be held from August 23 to September 15, 2021. All adoption fees will be reduced for all dogs, cats and kittens during this event.

6. FORE THE ANIMALS Golf fundraiser will be held at Mansion Ridge Golf Course in Monroe on Monday, October 4, 2021. Warwick Humane needs tee sign sponsors at \$130.00. Businesses and individuals can contact the shelter for more information to help make this fundraiser a success.

7. Currently they have 17 Dogs + 2 in foster care, 29 Adult cats, 46 kittens +9 in foster care and 5 rabbits for a total of 97 and that is all I have for the Humane Society.

8. The Town of Warwick Friendly Visitor Program this month the number of neighbors helped was 45, the number of volunteers helping those neighbors was 33 and the number of volunteer hours were 254. If you are interested, they are having 2 training sessions. The first is Tuesday, September 14th at 6pm at and Thursday September 23rd at 10am. If you are interested you can find palm cards in the lobby with the telephone number. The number is 986-1124 ext. 400. If you are interested in volunteering or if you are a senior person or sick person and you need help from them, you can get information at that number and like I said, there are palm cards in the lobby.

Supervisor Sweeton: It is a free service to any senior in the Town of Warwick. 986-1124 ext. 400 leave a message, the time you called and someone will get back to you.

COUNCILMAN GERSTNER REPORT: I just have a few announcements from Altice. They are going to be raising their rates on the video fees. I will summarize this in an effort to simplify the offerings of customer bills that will incorporate the video fees that were recently separated on customer bills. In an effort to minimize the impact on the current video customers, the company will issue credits on their bills to offset any increase that would have otherwise occurred due to theses changes. Any customer on initial acquisition promotional rates is unaffected until the expiration of their promotion, which is preceded by 30 days advance customer notice. The current monthly rate for a standard Broadcast Basic is \$24.99 and the monthly rate for video fees is \$34.98, it will raise to \$35.00. The

Optimum Economy current monthly rate is \$69.99 and Video is \$79.99 and it will go to \$85.00. The current Optimum Core monthly rate is \$79.00 and video is \$100.45 and will go to \$105.00. The Optimum Value package is \$84.99 and video is \$105.45 and will go to \$110.00. The Optimum Select is \$94.99 and video is \$115.45 and will go to \$130.00 and The Optimum Premier package is \$129.99 and video is \$150.45 and will be raised to \$155.00. SUPERVISORS REPORT

- 1. The Community Preservation Fund receipts for July were \$213,950.99 and the fund Balance is \$5,154,380.94.**
- 2. Kutz Camp update is we were able to work with the Health Department and the Department of Public Work's Bill Roe and get the pools open for the Town residents. It started a little after August and has a lot of use so far. We didn't charge residents this year so they could see it and understand it. So far everyone has seemed to enjoy visiting. So, we will have a plan for its use next season along with the rest of the park.**
- 3. Community Preservation Act Extension. This was a home rule request bill. This was the second year we submitted it. It didn't get to committee last year but I want to thank Senator Martucci and Assemblyman Brabenec who worked along side Assemblywoman Aileen Gunther to get the bill out of committee to the floor of both the Senate and the Assembly where it passed overwhelmingly and prior to the Governor getting into the dilemma he got into, he did sign the bill. So that extends the Community Preservation Act to 2050 which is a good thing for the Town of Warwick. It will work well for preservation of additional farm, critical open space and help also pay down the PDR debt that was incurred by the Town of Warwick residents. So, I wanted to thank them for that publicly.**
- 4. Warwick Tech Park Update is that all the properties that were purchased by the Warwick Valley Local Development Corporation have now been sold and that park now will complete its development along with the public amenities and that will hopefully within the next year complete the transformation of the former Mid Orange Correctional Facility to a public park and a private economic development area.**
- 5. Senior BBQ is next Tuesday, August 24th. It is open to any senior citizen in the Town of Warwick. Hopefully it will be a good day. We will have everyone spread out a little bit. It is outside so hopefully people will come out and enjoy. We've had a lot of interest from seniors and it is just a way to say thank you to the seniors in our community. The donations to fund it come from different organizations throughout the town and we thank them very much for their support. So glad we can keep this cost free for the seniors.**
- 6. Journal entries were done with the comptroller for the board's information, I did check each and every one of them and they were all good.**
- 7. The County will be holding a senior health and fitness day on September 14th. It's a Tuesday from 10am-2pm at the Thomas Bull Memorial Park. It's free for Orange County seniors. There will be a lot of health information, cooking demonstrations, prizes, Etc. #R2021-233 DECLARE SEPTEMBER PROSTATE AWARENESS MONTH

WHEREAS, each year approximately 175,000 men are diagnosed with prostate cancer in the United States, according to the National Cancer Institute

WHEREAS, men with relatives with a history of prostate cancer have a higher than-average risk of prostate cancer; and

WHEREAS, prostate cancer is the most commonly diagnosed form of cancer in men in the United States, and the second leading cause of cancer related deaths; and

WHEREAS, one in nine men in the United States are diagnosed with prostate cancer. African American men are 1.7 times more likely to be diagnosed with, and 13 times more likely to die from prostate cancer; and

WHEREAS, education regarding prostate cancer and early detection strategies is critical to saving lives and preserving and protecting families; and

WHEREAS, over three million men in the United States are living with prostate cancer; and

WHEREAS, all men are at risk for prostate cancer and we encourage the citizens of Warwick to recognize the importance of prostate screenings;

**NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by Town of Warwick Town Board declares the month of September 2021 as Prostate Cancer Awareness Month.

Whereas, an Environmental Assessment Form (EAF) dated August 18, 2021 was prepared to address adoption of the Local Law, and

Whereas, after comparing the thresholds contained in 6 NYCRR 617.4 and 5, the Town Board has determined that the proposed action is Type 1 because it includes the adoption of changes in the allowable uses within any zoning district affecting 25 or more acres of the district, and

Whereas, after examining the EAF, the Town Board has determined that there are no other involved and/or federal agencies on this matter.

Now Therefore Be It Resolved, that the Town Board hereby declares itself Lead Agency for the review of this action.

Be It Further Resolved, that a Determination of Significance will be made at such time as all information has been reviewed by the Town Board to enable it to determine whether the action will or will not have a significant effect on the environment.


